Attention Perris non-profits. The City wants you to attend a free workshop on June 25th to help make your organization a magnet for funding opportunities.

The workshop will be held from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. at the Perris Senior Center, 100 North D Street, across the street from City Hall. All required materials and lunch will be provided.

"There are a number of non-profits that have great programs which benefit Perris residents, but they don't have the infrastructure to grow their organizations," said Deputy Perris City Manager Darren Madkin, who is in charge of the City's Community Development Block Grants (CDBG) program, which is funding the workshop. "We're offering training for local agencies to get them ready for funding opportunities. This kind of training would normally be out of the area requiring travel and would cost hundreds of dollars, but we're offering it for free right here in Perris.'
